## Share project idea

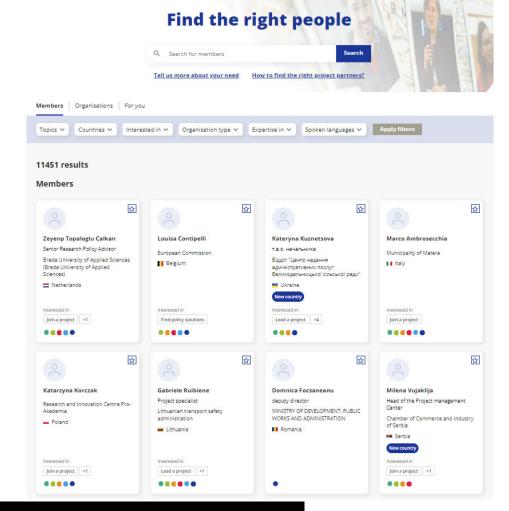
Publish your project idea on our website to tell others:

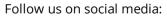
