
# The situation and the way forward


Bring forward the vision to a more unified region.

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


## **Reaching to a consensus**

- UfM, CPMR, ENI-CBC MED and West-MED should also have a leading role in the dialogue

## **Building the dialogue**

- Agreement on key issues of the dialogue
- Agreement on roles and responsibilities
- Agreement on the activities of actors to be considered as actual contributions to the MCGS
- Agreement on the sectors and fields to be included in the MCGS
- Define, Set up the monitoring structure & processes

- Develop clearly identified and contextualized, SMART indicators
- Develop an action plan on data collection & storage methods
- Risk Analysis
- Create a dialogue platform, link it with the layers of the MCGS
- Link the platform to the monitoring system
- Define and make known the methods for setting priorities

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
