CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW HEALTH CENTER IN COLLOTO (OVIEDO)

The construction of the new Colloto Health Center in the municipality of Oviedo aims to solve the problems of insufficiency and inadequacy of health facilities for the population in a neighborhood of the municipality that has been increased due to urban development.

The investment by the Department of Health was 2,244,945 euros, of which 80% have been financed by the European Union through the European Regional Development Fund, within the Asturias Operational Program ERDF 2014 -2020, and ERDF aid of € 1,795,956.

The new center that opened its doors in July 2018 will serve 6,274 people, mainly from the Oviedo municipality, but also from some nearby villages belonging to the Siero municipality, such as Granda and Limanes. Of the total users, 5,631 are adults and 643 are of pediatric age.

The center will mean a significant improvement in the health facilities of this area of Oviedo, which will go from having a small building with eight spaces to another of 18 rooms: fifteen consultations and three rooms of electro medicine, extractions and cures.

The office is located in a new two-story building and includes five consulting rooms for family medicine, five for nursing, one for pediatrics, one for pediatric nursing, one for dental surgery and two polyvalent. In total, 1,200 square meters compared to 200 of the previous center.



The ground floor hosts most of the consultations of general practice and nursing, the office of the social worker, the consultation of electro medicine and the rooms of cures and extractions. In the upper floor are the two pediatric consultations, dental surgery and the meeting room.

This action is considered to comply with good practices since it fulfills the following:

It has been spread widely among its beneficiaries and the general public

Information and communication have been a key element in the development and implementation of the center within the framework of fulfilling the objectives of the Communication Strategy of the ERDF OP, guaranteeing the publicity and transparency of the intervention and the increase of Public awareness of the added value of community co-financing through a wide variety of tools and actions.

Beyond complying with the regulatory requirements in terms of communication, with the poster announcing the execution of the construction works and the subsequent placement of the permanent plaque, once the construction works are completed, the contribution of the European Regional Development Fund to this project while the following communication actions have been carried out:

 An explanatory leaflet has been prepared with the most relevant data on the investment and the contribution of the European Union, which has been distributed among users and residents of the Oviedo municipality.



Visibility has been reinforced by the information contained on the Health Department
website of an information sheet of the center with the reference to the co-financing
received through the incorporation of the logo and the reference to the ERDF.

BREVE DESCRIPCIÓN DEL PROYECTO

Se trata de la construcción de un nuevo Consultorio Periférico con capacidad de prestar asistencia sanitaria a toda la población que se ha visto incrementada debido al desarrollo urbano.

Este nuevo consultorio supone una mejora significativa en las instalaciones sanitarias de esta parte del municipio de Oviedo, que pasa de un consultorio con 8 espacios para la atención sanitaria a un nuevo consultorio con 18 salas.

El consultorio se distribuye en un edificio de dos plantas y una más bajo rasante dedicada a instalaciones y aparcamiento de los profesionales. En la parte asistencial se distribuyen cinco salas de consulta de medicina de familia, cinco de enfermería, dos de pediatría, una de enfermería pediátrica y dos polivalentes (extracciones y sala de técnicas), consulta de odontología e higienista dental y cuenta así mismo con un área para profesionales. En total, suma 2.258 m2 de los que son sobre rasante 1.261 m2 frente a los 200 del centro actual.

El Gobierno de Asturias saca a concurso la construcción del nuevo consultorio de Colloto por 2,5 millones

- El plazo de ejecución es de quince meses y está previsto que el equipamiento sanitario entre en servicio en 2018
- El Principado congela por quinto año consecutivo el precio de las tasas de primera matrícula en grados y másteres de la Universidad de Oviedo
- El Ejecutivo impulsa la investigación y la innovación con 6,4 millones en ayudas a empresas y centros tecnológicos

El Gobierno de Asturias ha aprobado hoy el inicio del proceso de licitación del nuevo consultorio de Colloto por un importe de 2,5 millones de euros y un plazo de ejecución de quince meses, con el objetivo de que pueda entrar en funcionamiento en 2018.

Este centro sanitario da servicio a 6.274 usuarios fundamentalmente del municipio de Oviedo, pero también de de algunas parroquias próximas de Siero, como Granda y Limanes. De ellos, 643 son usuarios en edad pediátrica y 5.631 adultos. La plantilla está integrada por cuatro especialistas en Medicina de Familia, cuatro profesionales de Enfermería, un especialista en Pediatría y dos auxiliares administrativos.

La ejecución del equipamiento se financiará con 500.000 euros del actual presupuesto prorrogado, 1,7 millones con cargo a las cuentas de 2017 y 250.000 de 2018. El proyecto está cofinanciado por la Unión Europea, a través del Fondo Europeo de Desarrollo Regional.



• This high impact has been empowered by the institutional visits made to know the status of the action, highlighting the one carried out in August 2018, after the completion of the work. Attended the Health Minister, accompanied by the mayor local council, Wenceslao López and representatives of various neighborhood associations in the area.



All these actions have allowed all the target groups of the investment, the population of the municipalities of Oviedo and Siero, and of the region as a whole, to have first-hand information about the development and results of the project and the contribution of the European Regional Development Fund to this Health Center.

The action incorporates innovative elements

In the new Health Center of Colloto can be considered as innovators the location and design of the building to achieve greater energy efficiency and greater functionality in accesses, fundamentally.

It is a new building, modern, spacious, bright and surrounded by green areas. It should be noted that the building has the BREEAM (Building Research Establishment Environmental Assessment Methodology) certificate for sustainable construction, which is granted to buildings that pursue the rational use of resources (water, electricity, etc.) as well as ensuring a constructive process sustainable and respectful with the environment.

The thermal installations of the building consist of an air conditioning system by aerotermia which also supplies the heating and the hot water. This type of systems offers high yields with significant energy savings.



Adaptation of the results obtained to the set objectives

This project is coherent with the objectives pursued, since this action allows contributing to the social and territorial cohesion because it makes available to the users of the neighborhood of Colloto some facilities dedicated to family and community health more functional and appropriate to the needs assistance.

The staff of the health center consists of four specialists in family medicine, four nursing professionals, a pediatrician and two administrative assistants. In addition, the services portfolio will include health promotion activities, extractions, vaccination in adult and child, consultation on demand and home, healthy child reviews and rehabilitation and palliative care for people with chronic diseases such as hypertension, diabetes, obesity or HIV -AIDS. It will also offer health education, care for immobilized and terminal patients, patient care at the end of life, prevention services and early detection of diseases in the elderly and basic diagnostic tests in primary care.

Contribution towards resolving a regional problem or weakness detected


This new health infrastructure aims to respond to the important health needs for the existing population in this area. The construction of the new center represents a significant improvement in the sanitary facilities of this area, which went from having a 200-square-meter building to a 1,200-square-meter health center.

High degree of coverage regarding its target population

The construction of the new health center has meant a solution to the problem that implies the concentration of the population in the central area in the region, improving the attention of the

users of the health system. It has a high degree of coverage over the population, which makes it possible significant progress in universal coverage and quality of health services in the central area.

The new center serves more than 6,000 clients, mainly from Oviedo, but also from some nearby villages belonging to Siero, such as Granda and Limanes. The center is strategically located in a central area in Colloto, where most of the population is concentrated and has an excellent pedestrian accessibility.



Horizontal criteria consideration for equal opportunities and environmental sustainability

Regarding the sustainability criteria and equal opportunities, it should be noted that the location of health centers in a closer environment allows access to these health facilities with more sustainable means of transport, thus reducing emissions to the environment.

In addition, equal opportunities criteria have been taken into account, facilitating physical access for the entire population to these social infrastructures that have led to the elimination of architectural barriers allowing easy and comfortable access for anyone with a disability or reduced mobility.

On the other hand, regarding the design of the project and its execution and communication, special care has been taken both to the use of a non-sexist language and non-stereotyped images.

Also from the perspective of the principle of sustainable development, criteria for environmental sustainability and energy efficiency have been taken into account in the construction of the building criteria of environmental sustainability and energy efficiency both in the selection of the location area as in the integration with the environment surrounded by green areas.

Synergies with other public intervention policies or instruments

The municipality of Oviedo has a highly developed primary care network and some of the most important facilities, such as the Asturias Central University Hospital, the National Institute of Silicosis and the Biosanitary Research Foundation (FINBA).

The presence of these leading equipment's along with other facilities, generate synergies that make Asturias metropolitan area "an attractive space to invest in innovation and research linked to health".
