**6** The number of weeks the first Interreg Europe call for proposals lasted. It opened on 22 June and closed on 31 July 2015.




**261** The number of project proposals the programme received via the online application system with the supporting documents sent by mail.

**2158** The number of organisations applying for cooperation. They come from all Interreg Europe partner states.

**€205,413** The average ERDF co-financing the partners ask for for their cooperation.

**€441,021,813** The total ERDF budget the project proposals apply for. Partners from Norway apply for another 1,455,764 EUR of their national funds.








# Partners in approved projects




# Spain in the first call

Partners by legal status


